What are we working on for your guidance and help?

- Guidance Notes - Seven Property Guidance notes are already uploaded on the website. Five draft guidance notes are being fact checked with UKCRIC (thanks for their excellent help in verifying matters). These new are papers on Air Quality, HVAC, Financing Energy Initiatives, Procurement and Transport.
- A paper on refurbishment of Livery halls is being prepared as well as a step by step guide as to how to create a Livery Company action plan.
- Baseline greenhouse gas emissions. Always good to know where we start and Rob Casey is leading the group that is piloting a tool to allow Livery Companies to measure their baseline emissions (and so track the progress made). About 10 Livery Companies have volunteered to take part and it is hoped to share this process with all Livery Companies in a seminar later in the year.
- Welcoming and onboarding new members. A new group led by Gordon Masterton is ensuring we keep spreading the word and helping Liveries to engage and create climate action plans and share and receive help.

"An Introduction to Climate Change"

Ideal for anyone who wants to organise their thoughts on climate change and is in a position that involves leadership, governance or long-term planning in their work environment.

The course aims to provide a robust multi-dimensional framework for participants to reflect on and use as a structure to organise their own perceptions of the challenges posed by climate change and how they can personally participate effectively in the solutions to it.

The focus is on developing skills that help participants with framing and critically evaluating key questions before drilling into the answers.



One year on

The first seminar introducing the Livery Companies to the City Corporation's Climate Action Strategy took place on January 26th 2021.

Since that time the Group has:

- Run 3 more seminars attended by over 500 people
- Created a core group of 40 active Livery contributors and a wider group of individuals supporters
- Filmed 6 videos showcasing the work of individual Livery Companies (on website)
- Raised sufficient funds to create a website and run our launch event super-seminar
- Created a website <https://liverycag.org.uk/>
- Written guidance notes covering 9 vital topics for Livery Companies (on website)
- Galvanised several Livery interest groups to engage on environmental matters
- Signed up 36 Livery Companies to become members of the Livery Climate Action Group
- Formulated a structure of working groups to push forward our plans
